

Capacity Building Programme On COTPA,2003

At Canning Sub Division Hospital

Introduction:

Tobacco use continues to be the leading global cause of death and threatening to become an uncontrollable epidemic with 13 lakhs deaths every year due to Tobacco diseases.. As a result Tobacco related mortality is increasing day by day. Economic burden (both Direct and Indirect) of Tobacco use India, is estimated Rs.1,04,500 crores per year. In this context Tobacco Control Programme aims to reduce diseases, disabilities and deaths related to tobacco use. In this perspective **MANT** is on the way towards establishment of an effective and efficient system of Tobacco Control in West Bengal.

Planning:

Project Coordinator approached the Dy. CMOH-II, for conducting a Capacity Building Programme on COTPA, 2003 with the Health Workers (1st ANM) of Canning Sub Division. Afterwards Project Coordinator followed up regularly with the Dy. CMOH-II and District Consultant, District Tobacco Control cell, South 24 Pgs. Then Dy. CMOH-II finalized a date of Sensitization meeting on 16th Nov, 2017 from 1.30PM-4.00PM.

Focus:

The main focus of the Programme was to orient or sensitize the Health Workers(1st ANM) of Canning Sub Division regarding the burden of Tobacco use, Causes of Tobacco use of the adolescents and about a comprehensive enforcement through the implementation of **Cigarette and other Tobacco Products (Prohibition of Advertisement and Regulation of Trade and Commerce, Production, Supply & Distribution) Act. 2003** which can significantly reduce and eliminate the exposure to smoking. The role of ANM's was discussed in declaring smoke free Gram Pancayats in the district.
